

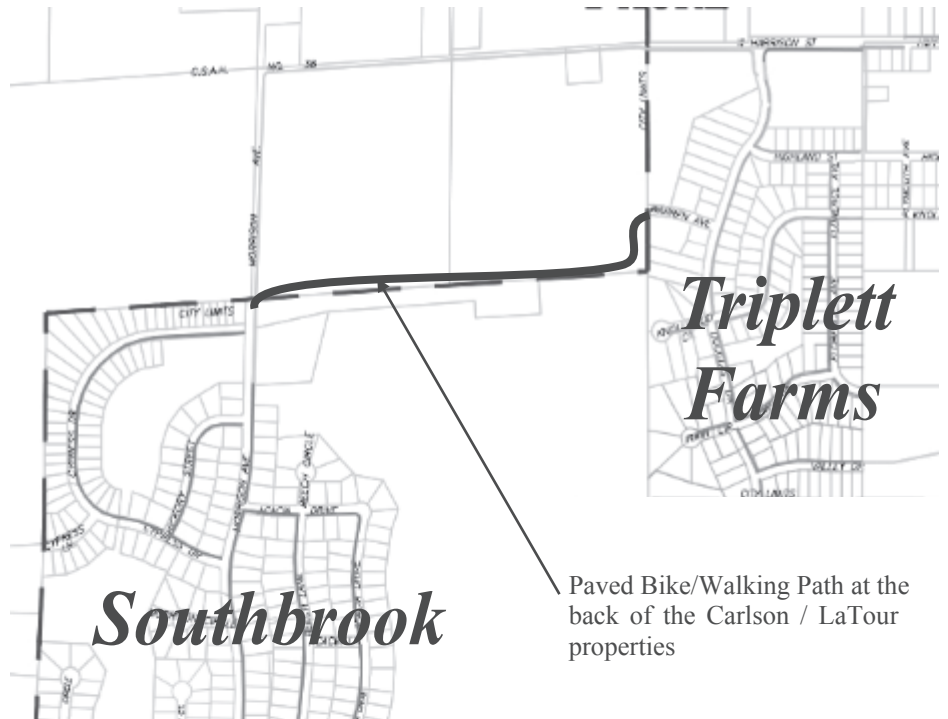


Trails Committee

Bike Trail Project • Spring 2009 *Southbrook to Triplett Farms*

In 2001, our community came together with a vision to create a walking and biking trail system that would connect all communities in and around Annandale. Through grant funding from the federal government, cooperation of our neighbors and donations from the community, the first step towards this vision is being installed this spring. This off-road trail segment will give our community a safe and peaceful path between the Southbrook and Triplett Farms Communities. This new trail segment will later be joined together by other new and existing trail segments to intertwine our Annandale area.

Because of federal deadlines, the trail segment must be completed by spring 2009. Right now we are seeking \$50,000 to complete this first section of the trail and to provide the local match required by the federal grant. You can help make this happen by providing a contribution to the trails. Join us in building trails for Annandale, one segment at a time!
